What steps will you take to implement your project? Be specific.

What community resources will you leverage to complete your project? (Metro Councilperson? Civic Organizations? Neighborhood Association? Volunteers?)

What funding will you need? How will you raise funds for your project?

Provide a timeline, if applicable.
